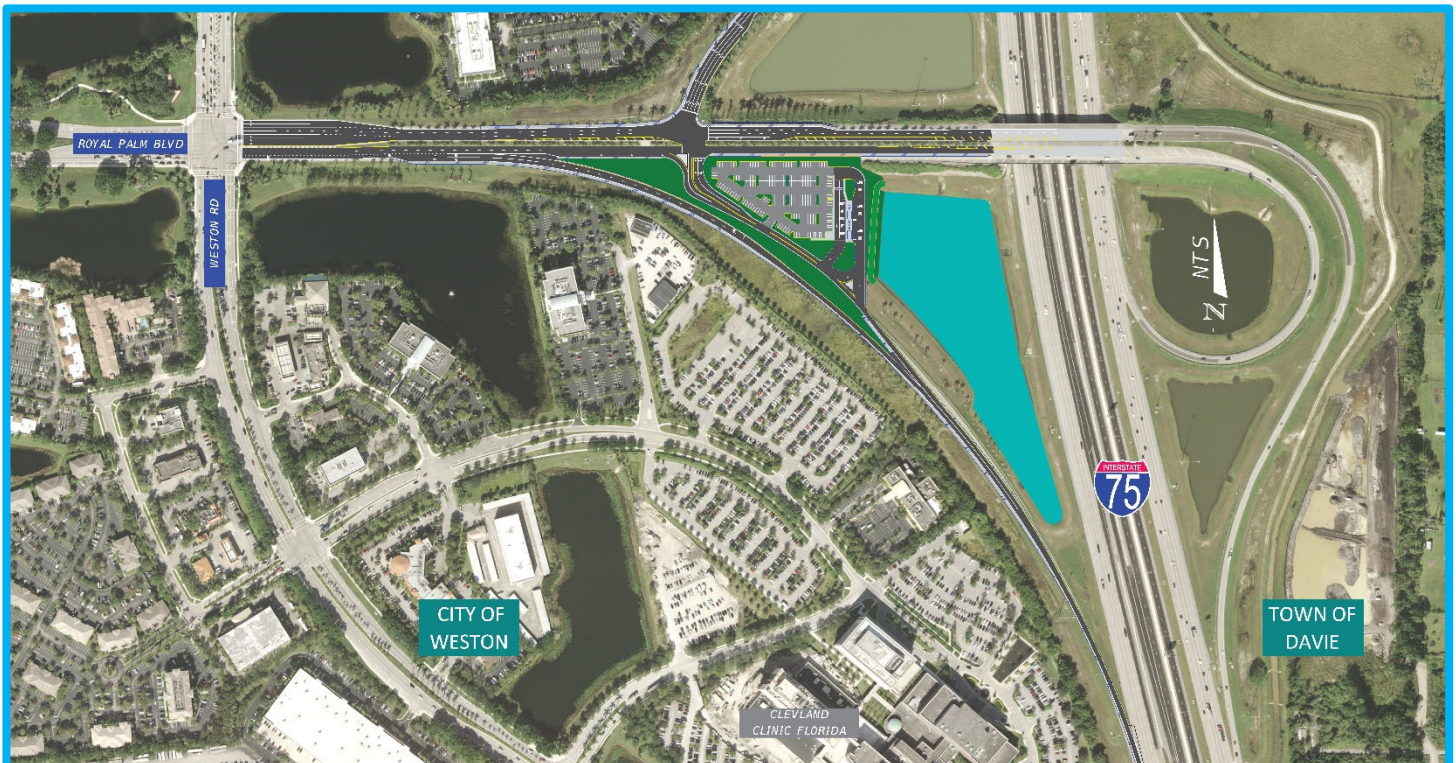

Site Selection

This location was selected as a result of a comprehensive market analysis identifying a significant number of Weston residents who commute to Miami-Dade County. To ensure it met the needs of Weston residents, site selection prioritized safety, ease of access to I-75 for Weston residents, compatibility with surrounding land uses, and minimizing impacts to residential developments.

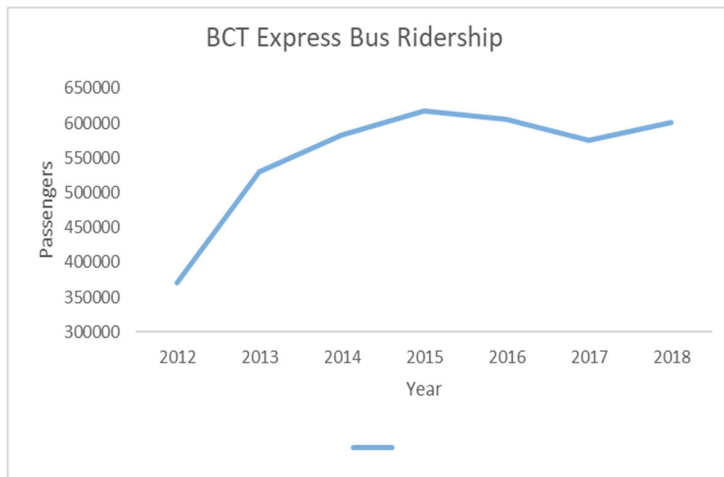

Premium Transit

75 Express Bus services will originate in three cities (1) Weston, (2) Pembroke Pines and (3) Miami Gardens. All routes will end at the Miami International Airport's transportation center (also referred as Miami Intermodal Center, MIC) with direct connection to MetroRail.

Approx. 160 passengers are expected to be Weston residents. Currently 500+ Weston residents commute via mass transit (US Census).

Buses are coach-style buses with comfortable forward facing seats, cell phone charging outlets and complimentary Wi-Fi onboard.
